FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. *What's the difference between the Ottawa Jewish Community "Foundation" and the Jewish "Federation" of Ottawa with respect to fundraising?*

- i) The "Foundation" holds and manages endowed funds and makes disbursements to beneficiary agencies based on a percentage of the available capital. The OJCF raises money through philanthropic vehicles such as bequests, life insurance, charitable remainder trusts, cash and non-cash donations, etc.
- ii) The "Federation" raises money through an annual campaign and distributes all of the money raised through an allocations process conducted by an Allocations Committee.

2. *Can the Ottawa Jewish Community Foundation (OJCF) help donors with planning their charitable giving?*

Yes. The OJCF has professional staff members to help donors understand the various giving vehicles available on the market today and are able to help donors establish plans to fulfill their philanthropic goals.

3. *How is the Ottawa Jewish Community Foundation (OJCF) managed?*

The OJCF is run by dedicated volunteers from the Ottawa community assisted by paid professional staff. The OJCF Board of Directors consists of up to 18 elected members who are chosen by the members of the corporation annually at the OJCF Annual General Meeting. 4. *Who can donate to my fund and how?*

Endowment funds are open-ended allowing for anyone to make further donations to the fund and to benefit from a charitable tax receipt for their gift.

HONOURING A SPECIAL BIRTHDAY

Annette Albert and her late husband Sam always felt very connected to Ottawa's Jewish community. They sent their children to Hillel Academy and were fully engaged in community life.

Over the years, Annette fostered that connection and her love of the community by working with a variety of Jewish organizations. She was co-president of Hadassah-WIZO, participated on the boards of Hillel Academy and Agudath Israel and currently sits on the Hillel Lodge Auxiliary. She is also a member of Na'amat.

When her children Ilana, Michelle, Sharon and David were trying to decide on a meaningful way to honour their mother on her 70th birthday, they came up with the perfect gift. They opened the Annette Albert Fund through the Ottawa Jewish Community Foundation.

Since the opening of the fund, Annette has inspired friends and family members to consider doing the same thing, which Annette believes can only bode well for strengthening Ottawa's Jewish community and the global Jewish community.

"When I think about this community in the future, my hopes would be for a community fully accepting of all people who live here and move here, open to hearing different voices and new ideas so that this great community of ours can continue to grow and thrive" she said. "It is also important to look for meaningful ways to educate people in the community about our ongoing needs so that they become inspired to get involved and work to secure this community's future."

Annette plans to allocate the money from her fund to Hadassah-WIZO, but, as the fund continues to grow, she plans to allocate to other beneficiary agencies within the community so that they may all benefit.

STARTING A LEGACY

GABRIEL HAMBURG

When my family and I decided to open a B'nai Mitzvah Fund in honour of my Bar Mitzvah year, I felt lucky to be able to donate money to a community organization, particularly since many people do not even have enough money to spend on basic necessities of life.

Yitzhak Rabin High School is the community agency that I have chosen to support with my mitzvah fund because I have heard so many good things about the school and plan to attend in two years time. I also know that Yitzhak Rabin needs community support both financially and through continued enrolment. It is also important to ensure we have Jewish schools because they help us increase our understanding of our Jewish identity.



LEAVING A LEGACY BEHIND

JEFFREY EISEN

When Jeffrey and Lois Eisen began finalizing their plans to move to Toronto, they made a decision to leave a parting gift to Ottawa's Jewish Community. While they had spent most of their lives living in Pembroke, and only six years in Ottawa, they had developed a particularly strong connection to Ottawa's Jewish community.

"The Ottawa Jewish community always supported our small community in Pembroke, providing us with Hebrew school teachers and offering other invaluable resources," Jeff recalls. "When we moved to Ottawa we were warmly welcomed by the Jewish community, making our transition much easier."

So, when they had an opportunity to donate a sizable life insurance policy for Jeff's business to the Ottawa Jewish Community Foundation (OJCF), their decision was a no-brainer. They donated one of the largest life insurance policies the Foundation has received to date. Jeff and Lois decided that the Jewish Federation of Ottawa's Annual Campaign would be the beneficiary of the allocatable income in perpetuity.

The result of this type of in-kind donation, which is becoming increasingly common, is that when the donor passes away the charity receives the death benefit from the policy. The Eisens had the opportunity to give tzedakah while receiving a significant tax receipt, and the OJCF received a gift that will support Ottawa's Annual Campaign into the future.

A SCHOLARSHIP FUND TO CONTINUE HIS LEGACY

BARRY FISHMAN Z"L

Barry had fond memories of his childhood in the small community of Sault Ste. Marie and being part of the shul where his grandfather was the rabbi. He was proud of his Jewish heritage, and he was mindful of its importance throughout his life.

When he became editor of the Ottawa Jewish Bulletin at the age of 50, Barry was delighted to continue the family tradition of service to the Jewish community through his background in communications. Barry dedicated himself to providing information on local events and personalities within the universal context. During his years as editor of the Ottawa Jewish Bulletin (OJB), Barry mentored a number of journalism students, always taking great satisfaction in their progress.

Barry continued to work as long as he could after being diagnosed with Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS) in 2006. Just days before his death (October 22nd, 2009), Barry suggested the creation of a scholarship fund to continue his legacy of journalistic excellence at the OJB.

Barry's dying wish came true with the establishment of the "Barry Fishman Ottawa Jewish Bulletin Scholarship Fund". The allocation from Barry's fund will be used to support a summer internship position (coordinated by the JFO) at the Ottawa Jewish Bulletin in perpetuity.



OUR DOLLARS AT WORK THROUGH AGENCY PROGRAMS

SHOAH (HOLOCAUST) COMMITTEE

"Never again" is more than just a phrase for the Shoah (Holocaust) Committee of the Jewish Federation of Ottawa. It is the motivation that drives them to do the work necessary to promote tolerance and understanding within the Ottawa community.

Teaching the lessons and legacy of the Holocaust, coupled with the promotion of compassion, courage and wisdom in human relations is the guiding mission of the Shoah Committee. Each year, the committee organizes multiple events and ceremonies to ensure that we never forget the lessons of the Shoah.

One of the more impactful programs the Shoah Committee organizes is Holocaust Education Week, attracting hundreds of people to special events, speakers and exhibits. Jews and non-Jews alike actively participate in these events, as the message of tolerance and compassion is a universal one that crosses all boundaries.

The committee also organizes an annual Yom Hashoah commemoration, a moving ceremony that brings the community together to "zachor" - remember the six million Jewish victims of the Holocaust, those who died and those who survived.

The Shoah Committee is also active in organizing public speaking engagements with survivors at schools and organizations throughout Ottawa. Working alongside the Ottawa Boards of Education and teachers throughout Ottawa, they have attended professional development days and hosted workshops for teachers to instruct how to teach the lessons of the Holocaust so that future generations will "never forget".

Last year, the Ottawa Jewish Community Foundation was able to grant **\$4,685** to assist the Shoah Committee, ensuring that these programs continue to thrive in Ottawa.

HILLEL OTTAWA - THE FOUNDATION FOR JEWISH CAMPUS LIFE

As the official voice of Jewish students on Ottawa's university campuses, Hillel's mission is to enhance Jewish cultural, religious, educational and social experiences of all post-secondary students in Ottawa. Hillel also promotes support for Israel through their student political wing, the Israel Awareness Committee (IAC). By offering an open, welcoming and pluralistic environment, all Jewish students are invited to find a place within the Hillel Ottawa family.

Organizing rallies to counter anti-Israel propaganda; developing partnerships with other students groups or working to maintain an ongoing dialogue with the University and College administrations are just some of the ways Hillel Ottawa remains on the front lines of Jewish advocacy, ensuring that our students can feel proud to be Jewish on campus.

Over 300 programs have been developed and carried out during the 2009/10 academic year. Thanks to funding from organizations like the Ottawa Jewish Community Foundation, Hillel Ottawa was able to offer a wide variety of services to students on and off campus. Funds help support programs like the "Matzo Ball Soup Hotline" - designed to deliver home-made "Jewish penicillin" in the form of chicken soup when students are under the weather. Financial support is provided to assist students' participation in leadership training opportunities, helping develop tomorrow's community leaders today.

Much-needed funds from the OJCF have helped students combat Israeli Apartheid Week, the front line for anti-Israel sentiments on campus.

Through the disbursement of **\$4,339** via the Ottawa Jewish Community Foundation, Hillel is able to offer new and dynamic programs and opportunities to the increasing Jewish university population, estimated at nearly 2,000 Jewish students this year from Carleton University, University of Ottawa and Algonquin College.

PINCHAS ZUKERMAN MUSIC EDUCATION FUND

Community support for Israel comes in all different shapes and sizes. One way the Ottawa Jewish Community Foundation is able to express that support is through the Pinchas Zukerman Music Education Fund, promoting the development of gifted young Israeli musicians as they participate in a world-renowned program with the capacity to be a springboard to help launch their lifelong careers.

Partnering with the National Arts Centre (NAC), the fund provides scholarships to bring talented students from Israel to participate in the Young Artists' Program of the NAC (founded by Pinchas Zukerman, Music Director of the NAC Orchestra). Guided by a common love of music, these students cross barriers of land, language and culture, while fostering the development of relationships and understanding - amongst the program participants and within their home communities and countries. This unique program allows us to forge ever-closer links between Israel and the Ottawa Jewish Community.

Since the inception of the fund in 2001, OJCF has been able to assist **12 students** from Israel to join this prestigious summertime program by granting scholarships totalling **\$42,000**. Included among the highlights of their time in Ottawa is an annual special concert for the residents of our very own Hillel Lodge, a definite highlight of everyone's summer schedule.

As a testament to the impact this program has on young musicians, a former student has been selected to return for the 2010 summer session as a pre-college viola instructor, showing that our support has come full circle.

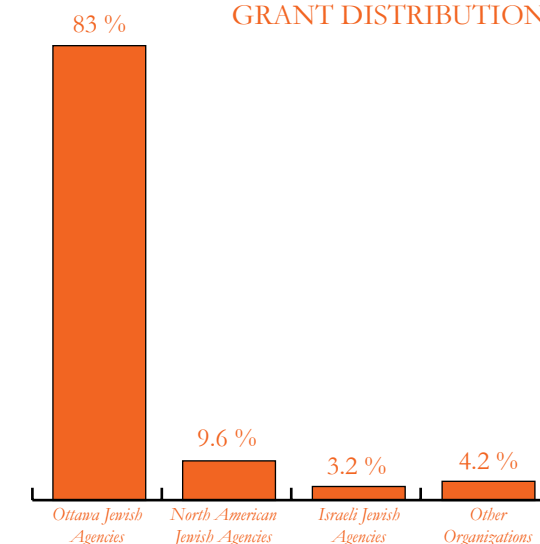

BREAKDOWN OF GRANT DISTRIBUTION



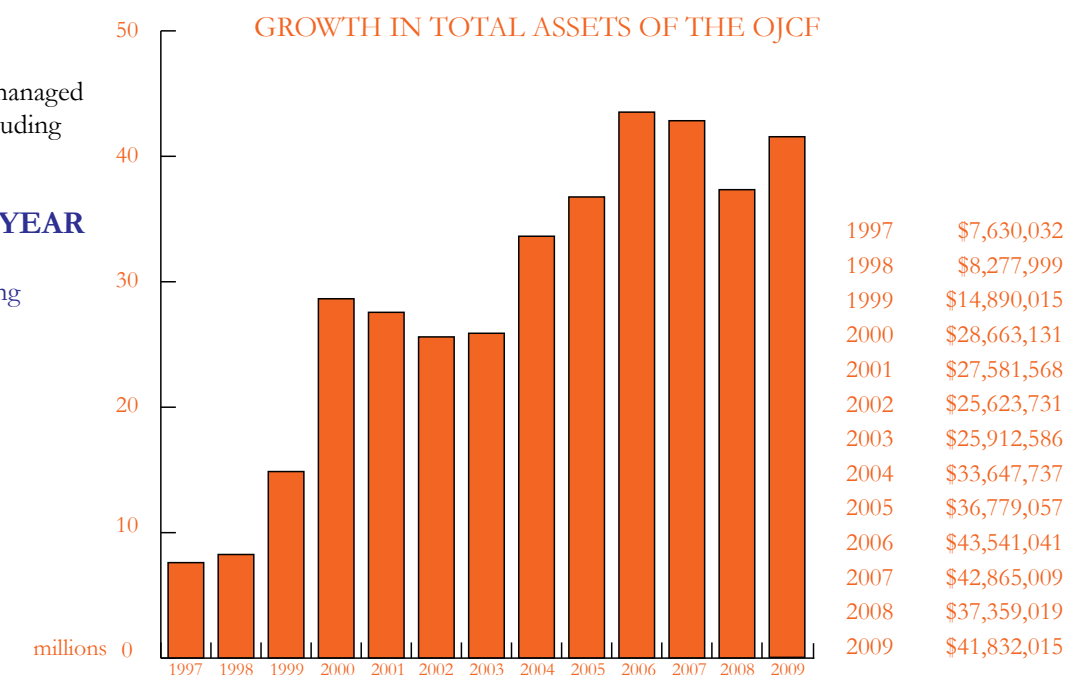
ACCOMPLISHMENTS IN 2009

The OJCF has over \$41 million total capital, including managed funds plus more than \$24 million in deferred gifts – including 114 insurance policies and Charitable Remainder Trusts.

GEORGE JOSEPH COOPER SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The George Joseph Cooper Scholarship Award is a prestigious scholarship grant awarded annually to a chosen recipient selected by the Scholarship Committee through an application/nomination process. The scholarship was established in 2006 by the generosity of a donor, George Cooper, who left a substantial bequest to the OJCF for the purpose of supporting an outstanding individual between the age of 18 and 30 in furthering their post secondary education or apprenticeship in the artistic, literary or social sciences.

To date, four recipients have been privileged with receiving the G.J. Cooper Scholarship Award. The OJCF has awarded a total of \$56,835 in scholarships since the inception of the program (2006-2009).

The 2009 scholarship grant in the amount of **\$12,457** is being presented to Hannah Mayne at the OJCF Annual General Meeting in June 2010. A graduate level student who will be starting her M.A./PhD program in Anthropology at the University of Florida in September 2010, she will be focusing on the anthropological study of Israeli culture. Starting as an active volunteer within the Ottawa Jewish community in high school, Hannah has

maintained her commitment to volunteerism in a multitude of locations around the world. A member of the Dean's Honour Roll throughout her undergraduate studies at York University, she has received several awards over the years for her academic achievements.

Previous award recipients were: Davina Finn (2008), an undergraduate student in the Faculty of Arts and Science at Queens; Diana Cohen Reiss (2007), a doctoral candidate at Ottawa University writing a thesis on Jewish immigration in Ottawa; and Ariel Goldberg (2006), an aspiring writer and Jewish educator who completed a BA in ethics from Ottawa University and Saint-Paul University. Jewish tradition teaches that one of our key duties is to make the world a better place for future generations.

Creating your Jewish Legacy does not only focus on cash gifts today. It also builds on your pledge to our community - a promise to leave a deferred gift (bequest, life insurance) - one that is planned today and realized after your lifetime. It is a promise to your children and grandchildren that our community will always be strong. It is a promise that our Jewish values will always be preserved.

Perhaps most important is the enduring nature of planned giving -- you may use your fund to honor or remember a loved one, perpetuating your family name long beyond your lifetime.

What is a planned gift?

A planned gift is a charitable gift of life insurance or a bequest in a will; thus creating an endowment fund where the impact of giving lives on forever.

Planned giving offers many financial benefits. If you give during your lifetime, you will receive a charitable income tax deduction. If your estate is subject to taxes, a gift made at death will provide a tax deduction.

When should you give?

There's no time to start like the present. A donor can be any age; give any amount; use most any asset and achieve personal, financial and philanthropic goals through a bequest.

A gift made to the OJCF during your lifetime provides you opportunities to watch your donation at work, and giving regularly allows your support to grow over time. Gifts willed as bequests may allow you to make a larger gift than would otherwise be possible and also help your estate realize significant tax advantages.

Most of us desire to find ways to touch the world during our lifetime, allowing us to make the statement, "I was here." Creating your Jewish Legacy provides that opportunity. Your legacy can reflect everything that is most important and meaningful to you, and you are assured that your work will continue and the Jewish future will be bright.

The B'nai Mitzvah Club, founded by Saul and Edna Goldfarb z"l in the year 2000, was established to encourage lifelong habits of tzedakah amongst Bar and Bat Mitzvah teens by opening their own B'nai Mitzvah fund. Through the generosity of the Goldfarbs and their dedication to sustaining Jewish values, they funded a grant program to match donations of \$250 up to a maximum of \$1000 to assist young adults in the community to open their own fund to support the local Jewish agencies that are most important to them.

LION OF JUDAH ENDOWMENT (LOJE)



A WOMAN'S COMMITMENT TO THE CONTINUATION OF JEWISH LIFE.

Many options are available for endowing a Lion of Judah gift (\$100,000 or more) such as a gift of cash, insurance policy naming the Ottawa Jewish Community Foundation as the beneficiary, bequests or transfer of stocks and bonds.
